How we handle your personal information

1. Your privacy is important to us

We know that how we collect, use, exchange and protect your information is important to you, and we value your trust. Anambah Electrical Services is committed to protecting your information and being clear about what we do with it is a vital part of our relationship with you.

3. Information Collection

This section outlines how Anambah Electrical Services will use data collected.

3.1 What Information We Collect

The information we collect from you may include:

- your identity
- contact details and;
- any information regarding your business that you provide

You may change your details at any time by advising us in writing via email. All information we receive is protected by our secure server. Furthermore, all customer data collected is secured against unauthorized use or access.

3.2 How We Collect Information

We collect information from you using the following methods:

- When you phone or email us
- When you fill out the contact us form on our website
- Information that is publicly available
- Information that is provided by agents, advisers and brokers

3.3 How We Use Your Information

We use the information we collect about you to:

- Establish your identity
- Manage our relationship with you
- Maximize the services that we provide to you

- Provide you with an accurate appraisal
- Contact you
- Conduct and improve our businesses and improve the customer experience
- To provide you with direct marketing as outlined in 3.4
- We may also collect, use and exchange your information in other ways where permitted by law

Information collected will not be used for any other purpose. Details are only supplied to a third party supplier when it is required by law, or to protect our copyright, trademarks and other legal rights.

3.4 Direct marketing

We may use personal information collected from you for the purpose of providing you with direct marketing material, updates regarding our website and industry information. However, if you wish to cease receiving any such information you may let us know either by email or unsubscribing at any time and your request will be actioned immediately.

3.5 Third parties

- We may exchange your information with third parties where this is permitted by law.
- We do not and will not sell or deal in personal or customer information. We will never disclose your personal details to a third party except the necessary information required by providers of products or services you have purchased or to protect the rights, property or safety of Anambah Electrical Services, our customers or third parties or if required by law.
- We may however use in a general sense without any reference to your name, your information to create marketing statistics, identify user demands and to assist it in meeting customer needs generally. In addition, we may use the information that you provide to improve our website and services but not for any other use.

3.6 Cookies

- A cookie is a small file placed in your web browser that collects information about your web browsing behaviour. Use of cookies allows a website to tailor its configuration to your needs and preferences. Cookies do not access information stored on your computer or any personal information. Most web browsers automatically accept cookies but you can choose to reject cookies by changing your browser settings. This may, however, prevent you from taking full advantage of our website.
- Our website uses cookies to analyse website traffic and help us provide a better website visitor experience. In addition, cookies may be used to serve relevant ads to website visitors through third party services such as Google Adwords. These ads may appear on this website or other websites you visit.

4. Keeping your information secure

We receive and store information outlined in 3.1. We keep your hard-copy or electronic records on our premises and systems or offsite using trusted third parties. Our security safeguards include:

- Employee education

- Destroying data when no longer required
- Periodical updates of our security measures in light of current technologies
